Survey of Healthcare Careers Course – Including Mental Health/Behavioral Health Career Exploration

Class Description:

An exploration of various allied health professions, including diagnostic, medical information, rehabilitation, and patient care services with opportunities for mental health/behavioral health career exploration through classroom speakers, job shadowing, and field experiences. This program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills necessary to work in various settings. Students will gain an understanding of the prevalence of mental health issues and the various mental health careers available. Students will receive college credit and a teen mental health certification.

Schedule:

- June 2, 2025 - July 3, 2025
- Monday & Wednesday 8:00 am – 10:50 am – Lisle High School
- Thursday: 8:00 am – Noon – Job Shadowing/Field Experience

Experience will include:

- Enrollment in College of DuPage course HLTHS1100
- Completion of Teen Mental Health certification
- Guest Speakers from Endeavor Health, Edward-Elmhurst Health, and Linden Oaks Behavioral Health, and other partners in the mental health/behavioral health field
- Career exploration, experiential learning, and field experiences in Mental Health/Behavioral Health



- May include some Hybrid experiences.
- 30 students will be accepted in the program.

Pharmacy Technician Summer Springboard Program

Class Description:

This program is designed to provide students interested in healthcare careers an opportunity to learn about the pharmacy profession. Students will complete 40-hours of classroom experience followed by 20-hours of job shadowing experience. The classroom portion of the summer program consists of lecture, online coursework and hands-on lab work. The outcomes are designed to guide students in learning the foundational knowledge and skills of a pharmacy technician role.

Schedule:

- June 10, 2025, to August 1, 2025
- Full participation is required, including online coursework and job shadowing.
- In-person sessions every Tuesday, 9:00 AM–12:00 PM, at the College of DuPage main campus in Glen Ellyn.
- The classroom component, including online coursework, must be completed by July 11, 2025.

Experience will include:

- Non-credit bearing educational experience, students will complete a capstone project where they will develop, complete, and present on how medication is being used in disease-management culminating in a final presentation.
- Job shadowing opportunities, experiential learning, and field experiences

Requirements:

- 16 years old and above with GPA: 3.0
- Classwork requires a laptop or desktop computer



- Job shadowing begins on July 14, 2025. Students must comply with clinical site onboarding requirements, including vaccination and drug screening. Licensing will be completed prior to the job shadowing experience. On the first day of class, students will be guided through the online application licensing process.
- 30 students will be accepted in the program.
